## THE EDIBLE GARDEN

Plants in the first section of the sale belong in the edible garden. Some are used as flavorings or garnishes, but, in one way or another, all belong on your plate.

Edible flowers such as calendula and pansy are included here. Also included are plants that attract pollinators or discourage pests. All require at least six hours of sun each day. Some may survive with less sun, but flowers and fruit will be more abundant if grown in sun.

### **OKRA 'CLEMSON SPINELESS'**

Very productive variety is a real edible ornamental. Pretty pale yellow flowers are followed by slender pointed pods. Harvest pods at three inches-if left longer, they will toughen and reduce flowering. Use in stir-fry, soups, stews, and pickles.

### **LEEK 'AMERICAN FLAG'**

Compact stem thickens but does not form a bulb as does its relative, the onion. Delicate flavor; can be grilled, sauteed or eaten raw. Hilling with soil extends growth of tender white portion. Leeks are cold-tolerant and can be left in the ground for fall harvest.

### **CHIVES**

Gardeners have grown this essential kitchen herb for over 5000 years. Lilac flowers are pretty in tiny bouquets, tasty in salads and as a flavoring for vinegar. Chopped leaves flavor eggs, soups, vegetable and cheese dishes, vinegars and butters.

### **LEMON VERBENA**

Strong lemon-scented leaves are a substitute for lemon in hot tea. Excellent for potpourri or sachets. Pretty container plant can become a houseplant in winter.

### **DILL, BOUQUET**

Early flowering with large umbels and dark green foliage. Used to flavor many foods from seafood to salads to meats.

**TARRAGON, FRENCH**

Strongly scented leaves can be used in chicken and lamb dishes and in sauces such as hollandaise and mousseline. Makes an excellent flavored vinegar. Good container plant. Bring into the house in winter. Prefers afternoon shade.

**ASPARAGUS 'JERSEY KNIGHT'**

Productive male strain requires careful planting and will need at least two seasons to establish. Detailed planting and care instructions will be attached to each packet of crowns.

**SWISS CHARD 'BRIGHT LIGHTS'**

Pretty and tasty. Stems may be red, gold, pink or white. Young leaves are great in salads. Mature leaves and stems delicious in stir-fries.

**BORAGE**

Easy growing, freely seeding annual with vivid blue, star-shaped flowers. Grow in vegetable gardens to attract pollinating bees. Especially good companion to strawberries, squash and tomatoes. Said to deter tomato hornworm and improve tomato flavor.

**BROCCOLI 'WALTHAM'**

Sturdy plants support 5-6 inch flavorful dark blue-green heads and lots of side shoots. Grown from organic seed. May flag in midsummer heat; produces well in cooler fall weather.

**BRUSSELS SPROUTS 'LONG ISLAND'**

Introduced in 1890's. Yields 50+ sprouts over extended period. More delicious after first frost.

**KALE, LACINATO**

Italian heirloom is as beautiful as it is tasty. Blue-green leaves are heavily crinkled. Tiniest leaves can be added to summer salads.

**KALE, RUSSIAN RED**

Tender, mild-flavored heirloom is tasty and beautiful. Oak type leaves have a red fringe; stems are purplish-red. Turns purple in cold weather. Surprisingly, big leaves are tender.

**PAK CHOI 'TOY CHOI'**

Dwarf Chinese cabbage. Tiny bunches of crisp white stalks with tender green leaves. Taste great sauteed, roasted or raw.

**CALENDULA 'BON BON MIX'**

Bright 3" double flowers on bushy plants are daisy-shaped in apricot, orange and yellow, blooming early from spring well into summer. The edible petals provide a finishing touch to summer dishes.

**PEPPER, JALAPENO 'EARLY HOT'**

Ripens before other jalepenos. Fruits are 2 1/2 inches long, 1 inch wide and turn from dark green to red when mature. Good pickled, in salsa, and in any dish that needs some heat. Compact variety from Mexico.

**PEPPER, POBLANO**

Mildly pungent with a sweet flavor. Dark green to red large fruits mature early. Vigorous, sturdy plants with good foliage cover. Thick-walled fruits are ideal for stuffing, roasting, in rellenos, or dried.

**SHISHITO PEPPER 'MELLOW STAR'**

Heavily wrinkled, thin-walled Japanese pepper is mild when green and slightly sweet when red. Thin walls make it a good choice for tempura. Thinly sliced red fruits are excellent in salads and cole slaws. Large upright plants.

**SWEET PEPPER 'ACE'**

Early, highly productive standard. Medium-sized, 3 to 4-lobed red fruit. Nearly every blossom produces a pepper.

**SWEET PEPPER, BANANA**

Large pointed fruits measure 6-7 inches long, 1 1/2 inches wide. Mild-tasting yellow peppers turn brilliant red. Favorite for pickling. All America Selections winner in 1941.

**SWEET PEPPER 'CALIFORNIA WONDER'**

Dark green, 4-lobed, large fruit with thick walls and sweet taste.

**PONDEROSA LEMON**

Grown from seeds of the Conservatory's Ponderosa lemon tree, these plants can be grown on indoors and placed outside in the sunshine for the warm summer days.

**CILANTRO**

Fresh leaves are used in Thai, Mexican, Indian and southwestern cooking. Cool weather plant. Seeds are the spice coriander. Allow some to flower to produce the seeds and provide food for beneficial insects.

**CUCUMBER 'SALAD BUSH'**

Great for patio containers, raised beds and small gardens. Full-sized (8-10 inch), full-flavored slicers produced on compact, mosaic-resistant plants. Bush variety may need vertical support.

**SQUASH 'BUSH DELICATA'**

Dark green, striped winter squash is plump and sweet. Flesh is white, turning yellow in storage. Sweet and smooth with a nutty flavor. Tidy bush habit, spreads 4-6 ft. Resistant to powdery mildew.

**SQUASH 'EARLY BUTTERNUT'**

Compact vine produces tan, medium-sized winter squash with fine-textured creamy orange flesh. Delicious sweet flavor. All America Selections winner. Harvest when skin is hard enough that it cannot be cut with your fingernail.

**ZUCCHINI 'SAN PASQUALE'**

Early Italian variety is a heavy producer of cylindrical green fruit with white markings. Lots of large flowers are good for stuffing. For best flavor, harvest when immature and not too large.

**ZUCCHINI 'SPINELESS BEAUTY'**

Fruits of slightly under a pound are medium green, heavily produced on a bushy plant.

**LEMON GRASS**

Strong sharp lemon flavor is good in soups. Distinctive flavor used in Asian cooking. Also used in tea, to flavor vinegars and as potpourri. Grow indoors in winter in a sunny window and return to the garden in spring.

**ARUGULA 'ASTRO'**

Salad green with tangy, peppery flavor. Dark green, lobed leaves form a loose open bunch. Prefers cool temperatures. Toss with sliced pears and toasted walnuts for a wonderful salad.

**FIG 'HARDY CHICAGO'**

Small sweet fruit. With protection, reported to withstand zone 5 winters. Plant in a container if you prefer to bring it indoors for the winter.

**FENNEL, FLORENCE**

Popular Italian vegetable forms a bulbous base of delicate anise flavor and crisp texture. Airy green leaves have a mild, licorice-like flavor. Use in soups, stews, slaws and fish dishes. Young shoots are an excellent tender vegetable. Attracts butterflies and provides food for larvae of swallowtail butterfly.

**STRAWBERRY 'CUPIDO'**

Firm, juicy, heart-shaped berries with good red color and delicate flavor. Disease resistant. Produces in late summer. Hybrid cultivar of two wild species.

**HYSSOP**

Small shrub with dark blue or pink flowers attractive to beneficial insects. Pretty edging. Plant near your vegetable garden to attract pollinators. Use leaves to season meat. Also used to flavor Chartreuse. Trim to keep full or let ramble and flower for the bees. Long lived.

**LETTUCE 'GOURMET BLEND'**

Carefully selected mix of colors, flavors, textures and leaf shapes. All perform well in cool temperatures. Pleasing to eye and palate.

**LAVENDER 'MUNSTEAD'**

Compact English variety with narrow green foliage. Good fragrance for sachets and potpourris. Lavender-blue flowers appear early. Attracts bees and butterflies. Provide good drainage and winter protection. Cut back in early spring to avoid "leggy" plant.

**LAVENDER 'PROVENCE'**

High quality oil production; grown for perfume industry. Light purple blooms on long stems. Great for cutting, drying and for making lavender wands. Attracts bees and butterflies. Provide good drainage and winter protection. Cut back in early spring to avoid "leggy" plant.

Tomatoes are tropical annuals and should not be transplanted until soil has warmed. Give them full sun and consistent water. To provide even sun for tomatoes in containers, move and turn them as needed. Determinate varieties take up less space and produce a heavy crop over a concentrated period of a few weeks. They are good container and small spaces choices. Indeterminate varieties are tall and vining and need stakes and cages. They continue to grow and bear fruit until frost.

**TOMATO 'BLACK CHERRY'**

Round, black, cherry tomato with sweet, rich, complex flavor. Vigorous tall plant.

**TOMATO 'BURPEE'S BIG BOY HYBRID'**

Smooth, firm, thick-walled fruit can weigh a pound or more. Bright red meaty flesh with great flavor.

**TOMATO 'BUSH EARLY GIRL'**

Bright red, meaty, medium-sized fruit ripens early. Great flavor and aroma. Slice for sandwiches, add to salads.

**TOMATO 'CHEROKEE PURPLE'**

Uniquely colored rose-brown fruits may weigh up to 12 ounces. Sweet flavored heirloom is wonderful in summer sandwiches and salads.

**TOMATO 'MORTGAGE LIFTER'**

Well-shaped, large, pink fruit is meaty with few seeds. This old variety is said to be named by a farmer who sold the crop to pay off a farm he was about to lose.

**TOMATO 'SAN MARZANO'**

Excellent for canning, tomato paste or puree. Rectangular, pear-shaped, bright red, 3-4 inch fruit is meaty with a mild flavor. Thin-skinned.

**TOMATO 'SUN GOLD'**

Very sweet, bright orange cherry tomato. Vigorous indeterminate plants bear long clusters of delicious fruit late into the season.

**SPEARMINT 'KENTUCKY COLONEL'**

Old favorite for tea. Good for headaches and upset stomachs. One of the best mints for sauces served with meats.

**MINT, MOJITO**

This authentic Cuban mint has a scent and flavor clearly different from other mints. A staple of cocktail lounges, it is essential to mojitos both alcoholic and non.

**Ocimum basilicum**

**Basil** is a family of aromatic herbs used in salads, sauces, pesto and as a flavoring. Beautiful in borders, mass plantings and in pots. Trim to prevent flowering, as leaves become bitter after the plant blooms. Pinch back to encourage a bushy plant.

**BASIL, GENOVESE**

Good pesto basil with heady, spicy fragrance and taste. Use fresh or dried. When flavoring sauces, add basil in the last few minutes of cooking.

**BASIL, LEMON**

Sweet, tangy, intensely flavored lemon basil. Long leaves and small white flowers make it attractive as well as edible.

**BASIL, SWEET**

Large, Italian leaf; best-selling variety. Flavor is marvelous for pesto and with fresh tomatoes.

**OREGANO, ITALIAN**

Both culinary and ornamental. Tiny pink or white flowers with purple bracts attract pollinating insects. Use fresh or dried. Leaves flavor sauces, salads and grilled meats.

**PARSLEY, CURLY**

Extra curly, finely cut, medium green. One of the most nutritious herbs; provides Vitamins C, A and B; calcium, iron and phosphorus. Use as a garnish and in salads, casseroles and soups. Flowers attract caterpillar of swallowtail butterfly. Beautiful, edible edging.

**PARSLEY, ITALIAN FLAT LEAF**

Also called flat leaf parsley. Contains more essential oils than curly parsley. Use to flavor egg, chicken and pasta salads. Add at the end of recipe for soup or stew as overcooking destroys flavor. Use fresh or dried.

**RHUBARB 'CANADA RED'**

Delicious and beautiful feature in the garden. Juicy stalks are cherry-red clear through and keep their color when cooked. If planting more than one, space three feet apart. For best results, do not harvest the first year, take few stalks the second, and following harvests will be bountiful. When harvesting, take no more than half the stalks at one time to maintain root strength. Leaves are not edible.

**ROSEMARY 'HILL HARDY'**

Bred to tolerate colder winters, this rosemary blooms in mid spring with large light blue flowers loved by bees. Upright plant has intensely aromatic leaves.

**ROSEMARY 'SPICE ISLANDS'**

Named for the Spice Islands Company, this is one of the best rosemarys for culinary use. Upright with thick, coarse, dark-colored leaves. Large flowers. Provide good drainage. Bring indoors in fall.

**SORREL 'RASPBERRY DRESSING'**

Deep red veins and stems make this a really ornamental edible. Tangy heirloom is good in salads and, lightly sautéed, on fish.

**SAGE 'BERGGARTEN'**

Large, grey-blue leaves. From Berggarten mansion in Germany. Use this culinary variety in stuffings, omelets, cheese and bean dishes. Great in tea.

**EGGPLANT 'GRETTEL'**

Solid, white, mini fruit on a compact plant. Should be harvested when they are 3-4 inches long. Tender, bitterness-free fruit is delicious stir-fried or grilled.

**EGGPLANT 'HANSEL'**

Compact plants produce tender, dark purple fruit in clusters. Not bitter and perfect for grilling.

**PLANTS FOR SHADE**

The following pages contain descriptions of plants selected for growing in beds shaded by trees or buildings. If struggling grass in hard-packed soil describes all or part of your yard, this section of the plant sale is for you.

Soil amendment is a good first step to a healthy shade garden. Humus from your compost pile, if available, is often needed, especially under trees with shallow roots. Mulch plantings with compost or shredded bark to conserve moisture. Avoid planting amid tree roots.

You may begin with spring bulbs that bloom before trees fill out. Their drying leaves can then be hidden with a shady ground cover like plumgago or ajuga.

For the rest of the season, choices of flowing plants include hosta, begonias, lobelia, and impatiens. Contrasting leaf texture, shape, and color will provide interest in a lovely, peaceful shade garden.
