THE EDIBLE GARDEN

Plants in the first section of the sale belong in the edible garden. Some are used as flavorings or garnishes, but, in one way or another, all belong on your plate.

Included are plants that attract pollinators or discourage pests. All require at least six hours of sun each day. Some may survive with less sun, but flowers and fruit will be more abundant if grown with at least six hours of sun.

Abelmoschus esculentus 'Clemson Spineless'

Clemson Spineless Okra

Very productive variety is a real edible ornamental. Pretty pale yellow flowers are followed by slender pointed pods. Harvest pods at three inches-if left longer, they will toughen and reduce flowering. Use in stir-fry, soups, stews, and pickles.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 36-48" Pot: 4p \$5

Allium ampeloprasum 'American Flag'

American Flag Leek

Compact stem thickens but does not form a bulb as does its relative, the onion. Delicate flavor; can be grilled, sauteed or eaten raw. Hilling with soil extends growth of tender white portion. Leeks are cold-tolerant and can be left in the ground for fall harvest.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 15-20" Pot: 4p \$5

Allium schoenoprasum

Chives

Gardeners have grown this essential kitchen herb for over 5000 years. Lilac flowers are pretty in tiny bouquets, tasty in salads and as a flavoring for vinegar. Chopped leaves flavor eggs, soups, vegetable and cheese dishes, vinegars and butters.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: 12" Pot: 4p \$5

Anethum graveolens 'Hera'

Hera Dill

Plants have a uniform habit, are slow to bolt, and produce high yields of ferny foliage. Tasty in summer salads, and with eggs and fish.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 30" Pot: 4p \$5

Beta vulgaris 'Bright Lights'

Bright Lights Swiss Chard

Pretty and tasty. Stems may be red, gold pink or white. Young leaves are great in salads. Mature leaves and stems delicious in stir-fries or simply boiled like spinach.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 12-24" Pot: 4p \$5

Borago officinalis

Borage

Easy growing, freely seeding annual with vivid blue, star-shaped flowers. Grow in vegetable gardens to attract pollinating bees. Especially good companion to strawberries, squash and tomatoes. Said to deter tomato hornworm and improve tomato flavor. Self seeds.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 12-24" Pot: 4p \$5

Brassica oleracea 'Long Island'

Long Island Brussels Sprouts

Introduced in 1890's. Yields 50+ sprouts over extended period. More delicious after first frost.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Brassica oleracea 'Red Russian'

Red Russian Kale

Tender, mild-flavored heirloom is tasty and beautiful. Oak type leaves have a red fringe; stems are purplish-red. Turns purple in cold weather. Surprisingly, big leaves are tender.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-24" Pot: 4p \$5

Brassica oleracea var. palmifolia

Lacinato Kale

Italian heirloom is as beautiful as it is tasty. Blue-green leaves are heavily crinkled. Tiniest leaves can be added to summer salads.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24-30" Pot: 4p \$5

Brassica oleracea 'Waltham 29'

Waltham Broccoli

Sturdy plants support 5-6 inch flavorful dark blue-green heads and lots of side shoots. Grown from organic seed. May flag in midsummer heat; produces well in cooler fall weather.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24-30" Pot: 4p \$5

Brassica rapa chinensis

Toy Choy Chinese White Cabbage (Pak Choi)

Dwarf Chinese cabbage. Tiny bunches of crisp white stalks with tender green leaves. Taste great sauteed, roasted or raw.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-20" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum

Poblano Pepper

Mildly pungent with a sweet flavor. Dark green to red large fruits mature early. Vigorous, sturdy plants with good foliage cover. Thick-walled fruits are ideal for stuffing, roasting, in rellenos, or dried.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum 'Ace'

Sweet Pepper Ace

Early, highly productive standard. Medium-sized, 3 to 4-lobed red fruit. Nearly every blossom produces a pepper.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-24" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum 'California Wonder'

Sweet Pepper California Wonder

Dark green, 4-lobed, large fruit with thick walls and sweet flavor.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-24" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum 'Jalapeno Early Hot'

Hot Pepper Jalapeño Early Hot

Ripens before other jalapeno. Fruits are 2 1/2 inches long, 1 inch wide and turn from dark green to red when mature. Good pickled, in salsa, and in any dish that needs some heat. Compact variety from Mexico.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum 'Shishito Mellow Star'

Shishito Pepper Mellow Star

Heavily wrinkled, thin-walled Japanese pepper is mild when green and slightly sweet when red. Thin walls make it a good choice for tempura. Thinly sliced red fruits are excellent in salads and cole slaws. Large upright plants.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Capsicum annuum 'Sweet Banana'

Sweet Pepper Banana

Large pointed fruits measure 6-7 inches long, 1 1/2 inches wide. Mild-tasting yellow peppers turn brilliant red. Favorite for pickling. All America Selections winner in 1941.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Citrus limon x medica

Ponderosa Lemon

Grown from seeds of the Conservatory's Ponderosa lemon tree, these plants can be grown on indoors and placed outside in the sunshine for the warm summer days.

Life Cycle: tender perennial Light: sun Height: depends on pot size Pot: 4" \$4

Coriandrum sativum

Cilantro

Fresh leaves are used in Thai, Mexican, Indian and southwestern cooking. Cool weather plant. Seeds are the spice coriander. Allow some to flower to produce the seeds and provide food for beneficial insects.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 12-16" Pot: 3.5 \$4

Cucumis sativus 'Diva'

Diva Cucumber

Tender, crisp, sweet, bitter-free and seedless. All America Selection. Harvest at 5-7 inches.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-12" Pot: 4" \$4

Cucumis sativus 'Northern Pickling'

Northern Pickling Cucumber

Short, space-saving vines bear early. Pick frequently at 3-5 inches to maintain good color and texture.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-12" Pot: 4" \$4

Cucumis sativus 'Salad Bush'

Salad Bush Cucumber

Great for patio containers, raised beds and small gardens. Full-sized (8-10 inch), full-flavored slicers produced on compact, mosaic-resistant plants. Bush variety may need vertical support.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-12" Pot: 4" \$4

Cucurbita pepo 'Early Butternut'

Early Butternut Squash

Compact vine produces tan, medium-sized winter squash with fine-textured creamy orange flesh.

Delicious sweet flavor. All America Selections winner. Harvest when skin is hard enough that it cannot be cut with your fingernail.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: Vine Pot: 4" \$4

Cucurbita pepo 'Early Summer Crookneck'

Early Summer Crookneck Squash

Compact bush produces meaty fruit with yellow, bumpy skin. Delicious flavor; fine texture. One of oldest (pre-Columbus) squash varieties.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4" \$4

Cucurbita pepo 'Spineless Beauty'

Spineless Beauty Zucchini Squash

Fruits of slightly under a pound are medium green, heavily produced on a bushy plant.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4" \$4

Cucurbita pepo 'Table Queen'

Table Queen Acorn Squash

Green-shelled, acorn-shaped squash is a good keeper. Sweet orange flesh is good halved and baked. This variety was introduced in 1913 by Iowa Seed Co.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-12" Pot: 4" \$4

Cymbopogon citratus

Lemon Grass

Strong sharp lemon flavor is good in soups. Distinctive flavor used in Asian cooking. Also used in tea, to flavor vinegars and as potpourri. Grow indoors in winter in a sunny window and return to the garden in spring.

Life Cycle: tender perennial / pot Light: sun Height: 24-48 Pot: 3.5 \$10

Eruca sativa 'Astro'

Astro Arugula

Salad green with tangy, peppery flavor. Dark green, lobed leaves form a loose open bunch. Prefers cool temperatures. Toss with sliced pears and toasted walnuts for a wonderful salad.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-10" Pot: 4p \$5

Ficus carica 'Chicago Hardy'

Chicago Hardy Fig

Small sweet fruit. With protection, reported to withstand zone 5 winters. Plant in a container if you prefer to bring it indoors for the winter.

Life Cycle: tender perennial Light: sun Height: depends on pot size Pot: 6.5 \$15

Fragaria x ananassa 'Cupido'

Cupido Strawberry

Firm, juicy, heart-shaped berries with good red color and delicate flavor. Disease resistant. Produces in late summer. Hybrid cultivar of two wild species.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: 5-8" Pot: 4" \$4

Lactuca sativa 'Gourmet Blend'

Gourmet Blend Lettuce Bowl

Carefully selected mix of colors, flavors, textures and leaf shapes. All perform well in cool temperatures. Pleasing to eye and palate.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 8-10" Pot: bowl \$15

Looking for tomatoes under *Lycopersicum*? Botanists have changed the name to *Solanum*. We offer as many usual now filed under *S*. Happy shopping.

Ocimum basilicum

Basil is a family of aromatic herbs used in salads, sauces, pesto and as a flavoring. Beautiful in borders, mass plantings and in pots. Trim to prevent flowering, as leaves become bitter after the plant blooms. Pinch back to encourage a bushy plant. Three varieties listed below.

Ocimum basilicum

Sweet Basil

Large, Italian leaf; best-selling variety. Flavor is marvelous for pesto and with fresh tomatoes.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-24" Pot: 3.5 \$4

Ocimum basilicum 'Amethyst Improved'

Amethyst Improved Genovese Basil

The only purple Genovese-type basil. Large, 2-3", thick, turned-down leaves. This stunning basil is nearly black in color.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 16-20" Pot: 3.5 \$4

Ocimum basilicum 'Genovese'

Genovese Italian Basil

Good pesto basil with heady, spicy fragrance and taste. Use fresh or dried. When flavoring sauces, add basil in the last few minutes of cooking.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-20" Pot: 3.5 \$4

Origanum vulgare

Italian Oregano

Both culinary and ornamental. Tiny pink or white flowers with purple bracts attract pollinating insects. Use fresh or dried. Leaves flavor sauces, salads and grilled meats.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18" Pot: 4" \$6

Petroselinum crispum

Italian Flatleaf Parsley

Also called flat leaf parsley. Contains more essential oils than curly parsley. Use to flavor egg, chicken and pasta salads. Add at the end of recipe for soup or stew as overcooking destroys flavor. Use fresh or dried.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun, partial shade Height: 10-12" Pot: 3.5 \$4

Rosmarinus officinalis 'Gorizia'

Gorizia Rosemary

An excellent standard variety with slightly wider leaves and very upright habit that performs well in the field or in containers. A good choice for culinary use. May be wintered over indoors.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: depends on pot size Pot: 3.5 \$6

Rosmarinus officinalis 'Prostratus'

Rosemary Trailing

Bred to tolerate colder winters, this rosemary blooms in mid spring with large light blue flowers loved by bees. Trailing plant has intensely aromatic leaves.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: depends on pot size Pot: 4" \$6

Rumex sanguineus 'Raspberry Dressing'

Raspberry Dressing Sorrel

Deep red veins and stems make this a really ornamental edible. Tangy heirloom is good in salads and, lightly sautéed, on fish.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun, partial shade Height: 10" Pot: 4p \$5

Salvia officinalis 'Berggarten'

Berggarten Sage

Large, grey-blue leaves. From Berggarten mansion in Germany. Use this culinary variety in stuffings, omelets, cheese and bean dishes. Great in tea.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: 16-24" Pot: 4" \$6

Tomatoes are tropical annuals and should not be transplanted until soil has warmed. Give them full sun and consistent water. To provide even sun for tomatoes in containers, move and turn them as needed. Determinate varieties take up less space and produce a heavy crop over a concentrated period of a few weeks. They are good container and small spaces choices. Indeterminate varieties are tall and vining and need stakes and cages. They continue to grow and bear fruit until frost.

Solanum lycopersicum 'Big Beef'

Big Beef Beefsteak Tomato

Still unsurpassed as the top choice for fresh market beefsteak tomatoes. Large, avg. 10-12 oz., mostly blemish-free, globe-shaped red fruit. They have full flavor - among the best - and ripen early for their size. Broad disease resistance. AAS winner. Indeterminate.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 72" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'Black Cherry'

Black Cherry Tomato

Round, black, cherry tomato with sweet, rich, complex flavor. Vigorous tall plant.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 72" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'Black Krim'

Black Krim Heirloom Tomato

An heirloom tomato originating from Russia, plant is open-pollinated, bearing 8 ounce flattened globe fruits that are dark reddish-purple to black with green/brown shoulders. Compared to 'Cherokee Purple,' 'Black Krim' is more productive and less prone to cracking. However, both of these gourmet picks should be harvested just as they become ripe. Indeterminate.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'Brandywine'

Brandywine Heirloom Tomato

The most popular heirloom vegetable! A favorite of many gardeners; large fruit with superb flavor. A great potato-leafed variety from 1885! Beautiful pink fruit up to 1-1/2 lbs. each! The medium-tall plant is best staked or caged. Indeterminate.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 90" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'Cherokee Purple'

Cherokee Purple Heirloom Tomato

Uniquely colored rose-brown fruits may weigh up to 12 ounces. Sweet flavored heirloom is wonderful in summer sandwiches and salads. Indeterminate

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 90" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'San Marzano'

San Marzano Plum Tomato

Excellent for canning, tomato paste or puree. Rectangular, pear-shaped, bright red, 3-4 inch fruit is meaty with a mild flavor. Thin-skinned.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 72" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum lycopersicum 'Sun Gold'

Sun Gold Cherry Tomato

Very sweet, bright orange cherry tomato. Vigorous indeterminate plants bear long clusters of delicious fruit late into the season.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: indeterminate - typ. to 72" Pot: 4" \$4

Solanum melongena 'Gretel'

Gretel Eggplant

Solid, white, mini fruit on a compact plant. Should be harvested when they are 3-4 inches long. Tender, bitterness-free fruit is delicious stir-fried or grilled.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4p \$5

Solanum melongena 'Hansel'

Hansel Eggplant

Compact plants produce tender, dark purple fruit in clusters. Not bitter and perfect for grilling.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24-36" Pot: 4p \$5

Thymus vulgaris

English Thyme

Upright, compact growth habit; excellent flavor. Dark grey-green leaves. A lovely border plant. One of the hardiest thymes.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: 6-10" Pot: 4" \$6

Plants on these pages have been chosen for their beauty and, in some cases, fragrance. Some, for example attract butterflies. Both perennials and annuals will be found here. All require a minimum of six hours of sun a day to perform at their best.

Agastache Kudos™ 'Mandarin' PP25381

Kudos™ Mandarin Agastache

Upright orange flower spikes held above airy, fragrant foliage. Attracts hummingbirds, bees and butterflies. Needs good drainage.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 16-20" Pot: Q \$10

Ageratum houstonianum 'High Tide Blue'

High Tide Blue™ Ageratum

Powder-blue, flat-topped button flowers with lilac centers. Foliage forms a dense hedge. Attracts bees. Trim faded flowers to encourage more blooms. Lovely in bouquets.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 14-16" Pot: 4p \$5

Alternanthera ficoidea 'Red Threads'

Red Threads Joseph's Coat

Unique foliage plant is densely branched with compact, tightly mounded habit. Adds distinctive color and texture to beds and borders.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 6-12" Pot: 4" \$4

Amsonia x 'Blue Ice'

Blue Ice Amsonia

Erect, clumping plant has terminal clusters of starry dark lavender-blue flowers in May. Narrow dark green foliage turns golden in fall.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun Height: 12-18" Pot: Q \$10

Anemone × hybrida 'Honorine Jobert'

Honorine Jobert Japanese Anemone

This is a vigorous, fibrous-rooted, mounding, compact cultivar which typically grows to 3-4' tall and spreads by creeping rhizomes. Single flowers appear on long, graceful, branching stems over an attractive foliage mound of dark green leaves. Lengthy August to September bloom period. No serious insect or disease problems. Highly rated in Chicago Botanic Gardens evaluation trials.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun, partial shade Height: 36-48" Pot: 4" \$6

Anemone hupehensis var. *japonica* 'Pamina'

Pamina Japanese Anemone

'Pamina' is an anemone cultivar that grows to 30" tall. Double deep rose-pink flowers (to 2" across). Highly rated in Chicago Botanic Gardens evaluation trials.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: sun, partial shade Height: 30-36" Pot: 4" \$6

Angelonia angustifolia 'Archangel Blue Bicolor'

Angelonia Archangel™ Blue Bicolor

Large, bi-colored flowers of deep purple and soft lilac held above glossy dark foliage. Grows well in heat and humidity; tolerates drought. Good choice for containers.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 12-14" Pot: 4" \$4

Angelonia angustifolia 'Archangel Dark Rose'

Angelonia Archangel™ Dark Rose

Large dark-rose blossoms with crimson eyes. Grape scent attracts butterflies. Good choice for containers.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 12-14" Pot: 4" \$4

Antirrhinum majus 'Antiquity Mix'

Antiquity Mix Snapdragon

Open-faced flowers in shades of pink, red and coral. Scent attracts bees. Blooms well into cooler weather.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 9-12" Pot: 4p \$5

Antirrhinum majus 'Liberty Classic Bronze'

Liberty Classic Bronze Snapdragon

Spikes of lightly-scented orange flowers have coppery-bronze overtones. Children love the classic snapdragon form of these flowers, which bloom well into the cooler weather, and make wonderful bouquets.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-22" Pot: 4p \$5

Antirrhinum majus 'Liberty Classic White'

Liberty Classic White Snapdragon

Upright plants with deep green leaves bear generous spikes of traditionally-shaped, fragrant snaps. Wonderful in summer bouquets. Blooms well into cooler weather.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 18-22" Pot: 4p \$5

Antirrhinum majus 'Montego Red'

Montego Red Snapdragon

These dwarf snaps are deep red with a bit of yellow at the throat. Lightly scented, they can make a border or fill a pot with color.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 6-8" Pot: 4p \$5

Aquilegia canadensis

Columbine

A native spring wildflower which occurs in rocky woods, slopes, ledges and open areas throughout the state, it features drooping, bell-like, 1-2", red and yellow flowers. Delicate foliage is somewhat suggestive of meadow rue (*Thalictrum*) and remains attractive throughout the summer as long as soils are kept moist. Flowers are quite attractive to hummingbirds.

Vibrant scarlet, orange, and yellow petals resist fading. Attract bees and butterflies. Disease resistant; tolerant of sun and heat.

PLANTS FOR SHADE

The following pages contain descriptions of plants selected for growing in beds shaded by trees or buildings. If struggling grass in hard-packed soil describes all or part of your yard, this section of the plant sale is for you.

Soil amendment is a good first step to a healthy shade garden. Humus from your compost pile, if available, is often needed, especially under trees with shallow roots. Mulch plantings with wood chips or shredded bark to conserve moisture. Avoid planting amid tree roots.

You may begin with spring bulbs that bloom before trees fill out. Their drying leaves can then be hidden with a shady ground cover like plumbago or ajuga.

For the rest of the season, the choices of flowering plants would include hosta, lobelia, and impatiens to provide color and contrast. Leaf texture, shape, and color will provide interest in a lovely, peaceful shade garden.

Actaea matsumurae 'White Pearl'

White Pearl Bugbane

Wands of fragrant, creamy-white bottlebrush flowers held above light green, lacy foliage. Prefers moist, rich soil. Protect from hot afternoon sun. Needs several years to develop into mature clump.

Life Cycle: perennial Light: partial shade Height: 36-48" Pot: Q \$10

Athyrium niponicum var. pictum 'Red Beauty'

Red Beauty Japanese Painted Fern

Rhizomatous, deciduous fern with an arching habit. Fronds are a soft grayish-green with an overlay of silvery hues accented by contrasting dark maroon midribs. Silvering is best for several weeks in the spring, becoming greener with warm temperatures.

Begonia 'Dragon Wing Red'
