



## 31st Annual FOPCON Plant Sale

### Presented by Friends of Oak Park Conservatory

For over thirty years, FOPCON volunteers and the Park District of Oak Park have joined together to provide the community with the very best in plants for our gardens. From the first “Herb and Scented Plant Sale” in 1989 until today, this sale has provided carefully grown plants while raising funds in support of our historic Conservatory.

Most of the selections are grown in our own greenhouses using integrated pest management (IPM) practices providing healthy, sustainable plant products. Many of our vegetables, herbs, colorful annuals and perennials are pollinator friendly, providing nectar and/or pollination opportunities for native insects including bees, butterflies, moths, native flies, and hummingbirds: These plants are marked with an image of a bee.



Due to current concerns related to the Coronavirus, we will not be hosting an in-person sale this year. **All customers should order online and select a pick-up window:** orders will be pulled and ready to be delivered to cars at that time.

The catalog is arranged according to three main categories (the Edible Garden, the Ornamental Garden, and the Shade Garden). Within those three categories, plants are listed in alphabetical order according to their botanical name. We offer our plants in a variety of sizes; 4-pak of seedlings (4p), 4 inch pots (4”), or tall Quart containers. All pricing is noted in the catalog. While we strive to keep the accuracy of the catalog as high as possible, please note that prices, container sizes, and availability of plants are subject to change up to and including the sale days.

This annual sale is presented by the Friends of the Oak Park Conservatory with the help of many dedicated volunteers. Your support helps the Friends provide quality educational programs, community events and other support for the historic Oak Park Conservatory.

**Please note: Because of response to conditions regarding the corona-virus we have limited the sale to the plants already growing in our greenhouses as of mid-March. This means that our selection of herbs is greatly reduced this year, and we have marked them as such. We appreciate your understanding.**

## THE EDIBLE GARDEN

Plants in the first section of the sale belong in the edible garden. Some are used as flavorings or garnishes, but in one way or another all belong on your plate.

Included are plants that attract pollinators (marked with a bee symbol). All require at least six hours of sun each day. Some may survive with less sun, but flowers and fruit will be more abundant if grown with at least six hours of sun.

*Abelmoschus esculentus* 'Clemson Spineless'  
**Okra 'Clemson Spineless'**



Very productive variety is a real edible ornamental. Pretty pale yellow flowers are followed by slender pointed pods. Harvest pods at three inches -- if left longer, they will toughen and reduce flowering. Use in stir-fry, soups, stews, and pickles.

*Allium schoenoprasum*  
**Chives**



Gardeners have grown this essential kitchen herb for over 5000 years. Lilac flowers are pretty in tiny bouquets, tasty in salads and as a flavoring for vinegar. Chopped leaves flavor eggs, soups, vegetable and cheese dishes, vinegars and butters.

*Artemisia dracunculus var. sativa*

**Tarragon, French**

Slender leaves of this useful herb may be harvested at any time for cooking. Insignificant greenish-white flowers are borne in panicles. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Beta vulgaris* 'Bright Lights'

**Swiss Chard 'Bright Lights'**

Pretty and tasty. Stems may be red, gold, pink or white. Young leaves are great in salads. Mature leaves and stems delicious in stir-fries.

*Borago officinalis*  
**Borage**



Easy growing, freely seeding annual with vivid blue, star-shaped flowers. Grow in vegetable gardens to attract pollinating bees. Stems can be brittle, so planting next to a fence can be helpful.

*Brassica oleracea Lacinato*

**Kale, Lacinato**

Italian heirloom is as beautiful as it is tasty. Blue-green leaves are heavily crinkled. Tiniest leaves can be added to summer salads.

*Brassica rapa chinensis*

**Pak Choi ‘Toy Choy’**

Dwarf Chinese cabbage. Tiny bunches of crisp white stalks with tender green leaves. Great tasting in stir-fries or raw.

**Hot Pepper, ‘Cajun Belle’**

All the flavor of a sweet pepper combined with a mild but spicy heat; the pepper to grow if you only have room for one!

**Hot Pepper, ‘Sweet Heat’**

Oblong, plump little peppers are mildly spicy, increasing in heat as they ripen to red. Compact, bushy plants can be grown in containers.

**Sweet Pepper ‘California Wonder’**

Dark green, 4-lobed, large fruit with thick walls and sweet taste. Great for stuffing.

*Capsicum annuum 'Orange Marmalade'*



**Sweet Pepper ‘Orange Marmalade’**

Early to ripen, sweet and flavorful, this blocky pepper turns a bright, gorgeous orange, pretty in the garden as well as on the plate.

*Capsicum annuum ‘Snackabelle’*



**Sweet Pepper ‘Snackabelle’**

Mini bell pepper ripens from green to deep red. It has thick walls and sweet flavor. Perfect for eating at any stage of ripeness.

*Citrus limon x medica* 

**Lemon, Ponderosa**

Grown from seeds of the Conservatory's Ponderosa lemon tree, these plants can be grown on indoors and placed outside in the sunshine for the warm summer days.

Life Cycle: tender perennial Light: sun Height: tree Pot: 4" \$6

*Coriandrum sativum* 

**Cilantro**

Fresh leaves are used in Thai, Mexican, Indian and Southwestern cooking. Cool weather plant. Seeds are the spice coriander. Allow some to flower to produce the seeds and provide food for beneficial insects.

**Cucumber 'Northern Pickling'**

Short, space-saving vines bear early. Pick frequently at 3-5 inches to maintain good color and texture.

*Cucumis sativus* 'Salad Bush' 

**Cucumber 'Salad Bush'**

Great for patio containers, raised beds and small gardens. Full-sized (8-10 inch), full-flavored slicers produced on compact, mosaic-resistant plants. Bush variety may need vertical support.

*Cucurbita pepo* Crookneck Summer Squash 'Tempest' 

**Crookneck Summer Squash 'Tempest'**

Ribbed, lightly striped summer squash have a rich, nutty flavor. Vibrant yellow color graces the vegetable garden.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 24" Pot: 4" \$5

*Cucurbita pepo* 'Spineless Beauty' 

**Zucchini Squash 'Spineless Beauty'**

Fruits of slightly under a pound are medium green, heavily produced on a bushy plant.

Life Cycle: annual Light: sun Height: 10-15" Pot: 4" \$5

*Cymbopogon citratus*

**Lemon Grass**

Strong sharp lemon flavor is good in soups. Distinctive flavor used in Asian cooking. Also used in tea, to flavor vinegars and as potpourri. Grow indoors in winter in a sunny window and return to the garden in spring. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Eruca sativa* 'Astro'

**Arugula 'Astro'**

Salad green with tangy, peppery flavor. Dark green, lobed leaves form a loose open bunch. Prefers cool temperatures. Toss with sliced pears and toasted walnuts for a wonderful salad.

*Ficus carica* 'Chicago Hardy'

**Fig 'Chicago Hardy'**

Small sweet fruit. With protection, reported to withstand zone 5 winters. Plant in a container if you prefer to bring it indoors for the winter. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Foeniculum vulgare*

**Fennel, Green**

This fennel produces seeds and fronds used in cooking. It also attracts butterflies with its bright yellow flowers. Upright, branching plant resembles dill. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Fragaria x ananassa* 'Cupido'



**Strawberry 'Cupido'**

Firm, juicy, heart-shaped berries with good red color and delicate flavor. Disease resistant. Produces in late summer. Hybrid cultivar of two wild species.

*Matricaria recutita* German chamomile



**German Chamomile**

Daisy-like flowers have white petals and a yellow center and a distinctive scent, caused by their blue essential oil. Leaves are long and narrow.

*Mentha spicata*



**Spearmint**

Rein in this fragrant herb which spreads by underground rhizomes and you'll have a great accent for many summer drinks and desserts...its small flowers have a lot of pollen which attracts beneficial insects.

Life Cycle: perennial      Light: sun, partial shade      Height: 12-24"      Pot: 4"      \$5

*Mentha x villosa*



**Mojito Mint**

This is the Cuban variety for authentic mojitos. This mint has quilted, fragrant leaves and a distinctive, less pungent flavor.

### Basil

**Basil is a family of aromatic herbs used in salads, sauces, pesto and as a flavoring. Beautiful in borders, mass plantings and in pots. Trim to prevent flowering. Pinch back to encourage a bushy plant.**

#### **Basil, Sweet**

This much loved Italian basil has large, long, glossy leaves, providing high yields all summer. Pick leaves often and remove flowers as they appear to prolong leaf production. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Ocimum basilicum*, 'Genovese, Amethyst Improved'

#### **Basil, 'Genovese, Amethyst Improved'**

Deep flavor is provided by these down-curving, red-purple leaves, especially good in sauces. Attractive ornamental, too. Harvest leaves often to keep plants from bolting. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Ocimum basilicum* 'Genovese Compact, Improved'

#### **Basil 'Genovese Compact, Improved'**

Deeply flavored Genovese basil, selected for compact plant size. Wonderful in summer salads.

*Ocimum basilicum* Thai Sweet

#### **Basil, Thai Sweet**

Green 2 inch long leaves have a spicy, anise-like flavor. Attractive plants have dark purple stems and flower bracts. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Ocimum basilicum* var. *citriodora* 'Mrs. Burns' Lemon'

#### **Basil, 'Mrs. Burns' Lemon'**

Light green, lemon-scented leaves are lovely in many summer drinks and salads. Pinch back to encourage bushiness and delay bolting. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Origanum vulgare*



#### **Oregano, Italian**

Both culinary and ornamental. Tiny pink or white flowers with purple bracts attract pollinating insects. Use fresh or dried. Leaves flavor sauces, salads and grilled meats. Can be potted up and brought indoors.

*Perilla frutescens* 'Magilla Purple'

#### **Perilla 'Magilla Purple'**

Vibrant magenta, chartreuse and green foliage plant is wonderful in large containers. Strong stems. Pinching will keep plant bushy. Provide fertile, well-drained soil. Water frequently.

*Perilla frutescens* var. *crispa* 'Shiso'

**Perilla 'Shiso'**

In the mint family, shiso is used in Japanese cooking, giving ginger slices their distinctive pink color.  
Beautiful in the garden.

Life Cycle: annual      Light: sun      Height: 12-36"      Pot: 4      \$5

*Petroselinum crispum* var. *neapolitanum*

**Parsley, Italian Flat leaf**

Also called flat leaf parsley. Contains more essential oils than curly parsley. Use to flavor egg, chicken and pasta salads. Add at the end of recipe for soup or stew as overcooking destroys flavor. Use fresh or dried. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Physalis philadelphica*

**Tomatillo**

No relation to the tomato, tomatillos bear small, round, green fruits that are a staple of Mexican cuisine, starring in salsa verde. Staking is recommended.

*Rosmarinus officinalis* 'Gorizia'



**Rosemary 'Gorizia'**

An excellent standard variety with slightly wider leaves and very upright habit that performs well in the garden or in containers. A good choice for culinary use. May be wintered over indoors.

**Rosemary, Creeping**

This rosemary blooms in mid-spring with large light blue flowers loved by bees. Trailing plant has intensely aromatic leaves. Attractive in pots. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

*Rumex sanguineus* 'Raspberry Dressing'



**Sorrel 'Raspberry Dressing'**

Deep red veins and stems make this a really ornamental edible. Tangy heirloom is good in salads and, lightly sautéed, on fish.

Life Cycle: perennial      Light: sun, partial shade      Height: 6-12"      Pot: 4p      \$5

## Tomatoes

**Tomatoes are tropical annuals and should not be transplanted until soil has warmed. Give them full sun and consistent water. To provide even sun for tomatoes in containers, move and turn them as needed. Indeterminate varieties are tall and vining and need stakes and cages. They continue to grow and bear fruit until frost.**

**Cherry Tomato 'Chocolate Cherry'**

One-inch fruits are rich deep red with chocolate shading. Tasty to snack on or in salads.

*Solanum lycopersicum* 'Chocolate Sprinkles'

**Cherry Tomato 'Chocolate Sprinkles'**

Round, black, cherry tomato with sweet, rich, complex flavor. Vigorous tall plant.

*Solanum lycopersicum* 'Sun Gold'

**Cherry Tomato 'Sun Gold'**

Very sweet, bright orange cherry tomato. Vigorous indeterminate plants bear long clusters of delicious fruit late into the season.

**Heirloom Tomato 'Brandywine'**

The most popular heirloom tomato, a favorite of many gardeners; large fruit with superb flavor. A great potato-leaved variety from 1885. Beautiful pink fruit up to 1-1/2 lbs. each! The medium-tall plant is best staked or caged.

**Heirloom Tomato 'Cherokee Purple'**

Sweet-flavored heirloom has uniquely-colored rose-brown fruits.

*Solanum lycopersicum* 'Fourth of July'

**Tomato 'Fourth of July'**

Its name tells you this is a very early tomato. Mid-sized red fruits are produced steadily all summer, providing sandwich slices whenever wanted.

*Solanum lycopersicum* 'Mortgage Lifter'

**Beefsteak Tomato 'Mortgage Lifter'**

The story of this tomato is that its discoverer was able to pay off his mortgage with its proceeds. This variety produces huge beefsteak tomatoes with great flavor. An indeterminate plant, it continues to grow and produce until frost but requires staking or caging.

*Solanum lycopersicum* 'San Marzano'

**Plum Tomato 'San Marzano'**

Excellent for canning, tomato paste or puree. Rectangular, pear-shaped, bright red, 3-4 inch fruit is meaty with a mild flavor. Thin-skinned.

*Solanum melongena* var. *esculentum* 'Annina'



**Eggplant 'Annina'**

Glossy purple and white striped eggplants are tasty in the kitchen and beautiful in the garden, too.

Productive plants are nearly spineless.

*Solanum melongena* 'Hansel'



**Eggplant 'Hansel'**

Compact plants produce tender, dark purple fruit in clusters. Not bitter and perfect for grilling.

*Stevia rebaudiana*

**Stevia**

Leaves of this plant are used as a sweetener and sugar substitute. Good fresh in salads, it is also a graceful addition to garden beds, with finely scalloped light green leaves. **UNAVAILABLE FOR 2020**

**Thyme, English**

Upright, compact growth habit; excellent flavor. Dark grey-green leaves. A lovely border plant. One of the hardiest thymes.

## THE ORNAMENTAL GARDEN

Plants on these pages have been chosen for their beauty and, in some cases, fragrance. Some, for example attract butterflies. Both perennials and annuals will be found here. All require a minimum of six hours of sun a day to perform at their best.

*Allium 'Serendipity'*



**Ornamental Onion**

This hybrid ornamental onion grows well in our clay soil in full sun or part shade. Bearing round puffs of purple flowers, it grows 15" to 20". Bees and butterflies are attracted; deer and rabbits aren't.

*Anemone × hybrida 'Honore Jobert'*

**Japanese Anemone 'Honore Jobert'**

This is a vigorous, mounding, compact cultivar which typically grows to 3-4' tall and spreads by creeping rhizomes. Single flowers appear on long, graceful, branching stems over an attractive foliage mound of dark green leaves. Lengthy August to September bloom period. No serious insect or disease problems. Highly rated in Chicago Botanic Gardens evaluation trials.

*Angelonia angustifolia 'Angel Face Blue'*

**Angelonia 'Angel Face Blue'**

A wonderful plant for pots. Its upright branches carry gorgeous blue flowers all summer. The foliage is fragrant; the flowers require no deadheading for continuous bloom.

Life Cycle: annual      Light: sun      Height: 18-30"      Pot: 4"      \$5

*Angelonia angustifolia 'Angel Face Perfectly Pink'*

**Angelonia 'Angel Face Perfectly Pink'**

Warm purple-pink flowers cover this long-blooming favorite, ideal for pots as well as garden beds. Fragrant foliage, Handles heat and dry conditions.

*Antirrhinum majus 'Antiquity Mix'*



**Snapdragon 'Antiquity Mix'**

Open-faced flowers in shades of pink, red and coral. Scent attracts bees. Blooms well into cooler weather.

Life Cycle: annual      Light: sun      Height: 9-12"      Pot: 4"      \$5

*Antirrhinum majus 'Costa Apricot'*



**Snapdragon 'Costa Apricot'**

Spikes of apricot flowers are lightly scented. Children love the classic snapdragon form of these flowers, which bloom well into the cooler weather and make wonderful bouquets.

*Antirrhinum majus* 'Potomac Yellow'  
**Snapdragon 'Potomac Yellow'**



Upright plants with deep green leaves bear generous spikes of cheery lemon-yellow snaps. Wonderful in summer bouquets. Blooms well into cooler weather.

## PLANTS FOR SHADE

The following pages contain descriptions of plants selected for growing in beds shaded by trees or buildings. If struggling grass in hard-packed soil describes all or part of your yard, this section of the plant sale is for you.

Soil amendment is a good first step to a healthy shade garden. Humus from your compost pile, if available, is often needed, especially under trees with shallow roots. Mulch plantings with wood chips or shredded bark to conserve moisture. Avoid planting amid tree roots.

You may begin with spring bulbs that bloom before trees fill out. Their drying leaves can then be hidden with a shady ground cover.

For the rest of the season, the choices of flowering plants would include lobelia and impatiens to provide color and contrast. Leaf texture, shape, and color will provide interest in a lovely, peaceful shade garden.
